General Rules:

- Teams must have registration form and \$10 registration fee submitted to Fast Friends by August 30, 2011.
- Chili is defined as any kind of spicy, stew-like dish cooked with chili peppers, meat (optional), and/or beans (optional). Various other spices and ingredients may be added with the exception of rice or pasta.
- Contestants must bring a minimum of 2 gallons of chili for public tasting and 1 pint for the Judges Table.
- Limit of 4 persons per cook-off team, 2 person minimum.
- A list of ingredients must be displayed at table. You do not have to list quantities.
- Participants are responsible for cleaning their area after the event.
- Chili must be fully prepared at home and transported to the event ready to eat.
- Must bring your own chairs, tents and utensils. Tables will be provided. There will be 2 teams per 8ft table. If you would like to bring your own table please let us know.
- 2 ounce tasting cups, ballots and containers for ballots for People's Choice Award will be provided.
- Chili must be kept hot during event. Limited electrical outlets available. Electricity will be provided to first 12 registrants that need it. ****Bring Heavy Duty Extension Cord**** Otherwise, contestants must keep chili warm by using coleman type propane stoves or sterno under chaffing dishes.
- Chili will be judged by a panel of judges. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be awarded based on taste, consistency, aroma, texture and appearance. There will also be a People's Choice Award. All attendees will be given a ballot to cast their vote for best chili upon entering.
